

Animal Exhibition Checklist for the Washburn County Fair

All exhibitors of animals must meet the entry deadline of June 29, 2012.

All exhibitors of Sheep, Swine, Dairy, Beef, and/or Goats must submit a paper copy of the Pen Request form.

All animals must be on the fairgrounds by Thursday, July 26, 2011, by noon unless noted otherwise.

Beef

- _____ 3/8" rope or chain to tie animal
- _____ if animal has horns they must be less than 2"
- _____ bulls are not to be over 1 year old and 800 pounds
- _____ need an ear tag or tattoo

Dairy (must be on fairgrounds by 6pm Thursday, July 26, 2011)

- _____ 3/8" rope or chain to tie animal
- _____ if animal has horns they must be less than 2"
- _____ bulls are not to be over 1 year old and 800 pounds
- _____ need an ear tag or tattoo

Swine

- _____ must have health papers from a vet check within 30 days of fair
- _____ boars must have tusks removed

Sheep (must be on fairgrounds Wednesday, July 25, 2012 in the evening)

- _____ sexually intact sheep and sheep over 12 months old must have a scrapie ear tag
- _____ must have been shorn within 2 months of the fair unless a registered Columbia, Corriedales, Rambouillets, Targhees, or any other wool breed which are to be shown with up to 2" of wool

Goats

- _____ sexually intact goats and goats over 12 months old must have a scrapie ear tag or traceable tattoo

Poultry (must be on fairgrounds Wednesday, July 25, 2012, during the vet check times)

- _____ must be blood tested during the vet check in if older than 4 months
- _____ turkeys must have testing, arrangements for testing need to be made through fair secretary and/or poultry superintendent at least one month prior to fair

Rabbits (must be on fairgrounds Wednesday, July 25, 2012, during the vet check times)

- _____ must be examined by the vet during the vet check in

Horse

- _____ must have a negative coggins test dated within the current year

Dogs

- _____ must have veterinary proof of rabies, distemper/parvo, and bordetella vaccines
- _____ must have a current license
- _____ must be present for judging only which is Monday, July 23, 2012
- _____ exhibitor and dog must have met meeting attendance requirements set by project leader

Llamas

- _____ may stay on grounds or may go home at discretion of exhibitor

Pets

- _____ must be present for judging only which is Tuesday, July 24, 2012
- _____ ferrets must have rabies vaccine
- _____ must be brought in their own cage

Cats

- _____ must have veterinary proof of rabies and panleukopenia/distemper vaccines given at least 3 weeks prior to fair
- _____ males over 8 months must be neutered
- _____ must be present for judging only which is Tuesday, July 24, 2012
- _____ must be brought in their own carrier and wear a harness and leash outside of it
